3. **Group Health Insurance Options for MCCPRA October 1 Re-enrollment**
 - A. **Review Plan Options-** Tom Dorywalski, of Taylor Insurance, presented seven group health insurance options available to MCCPRA beginning October 1. All quotes were dramatically increased over the 2017 insurance rate due to 2017 being a high claims year for our Authority. This plan would be a budget increase of 21%. Staff premiums would also go up in some cases as much as 60%. However, compared to the other plans available, Terry Peek explained that he and Sheree Hamilton felt Lifestyle Healthy 1002500 seemed to be the best available coverage with similar options for MCCPRA at the best price.
 - B. **Consider Approving Group Health Insurance Plan for re-enrollment-** After discussions of the available plans, Terry Peek recommended staying with the current provider and accepting the Lifestyle 1002500 plan as discussed above. A motion was made by Brad Gregory to approve the Lifestyle 1002500 plan from Medova. Bob Swadel seconded the motion. **Motion was approved unanimously.**
